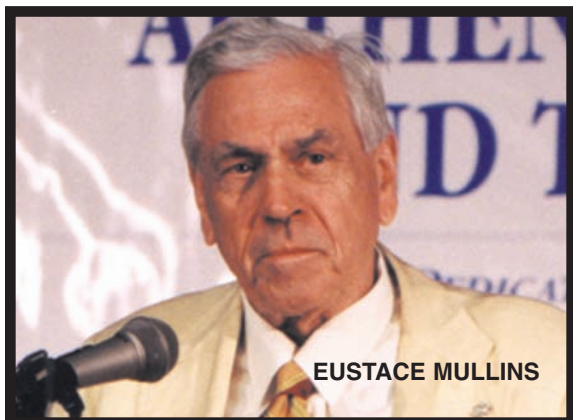


Geologist, human rights activist claim quake caused by drilling
